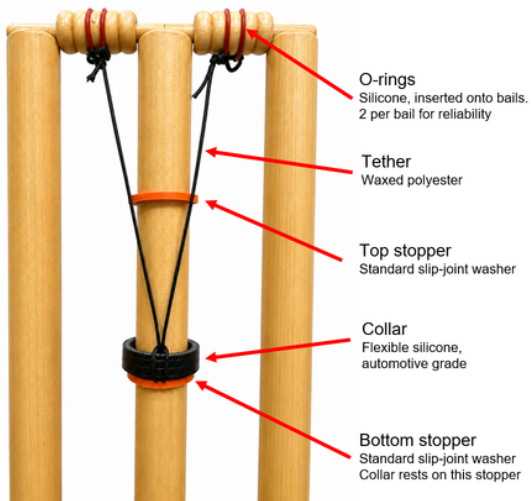


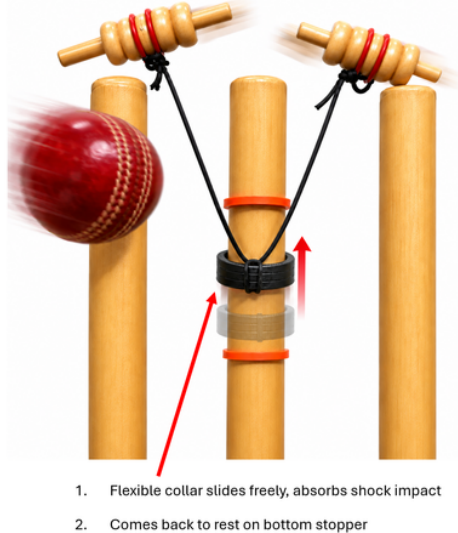
Bail Guard - How to Install

Bail Guard - A safety device to reduce injuries due to flying bails

Initial setup



On ball impact

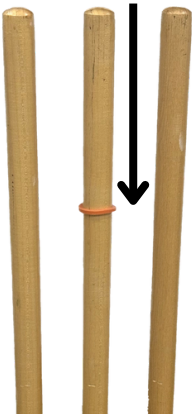


Compliant with MCC Law 8.3.4

“ Devices aimed at protecting player safety by limiting the distance that a bail can travel off the stumps will be allowed, subject to the approval of the Governing Body for the match and the ground authority. ”

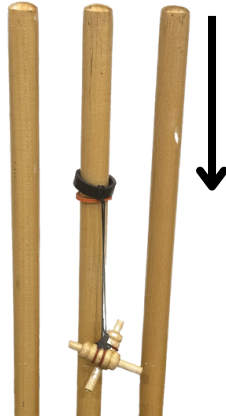

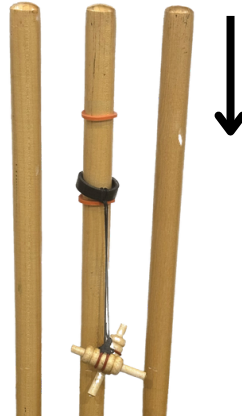
Insert bottom stopper

2



Insert collar

3



Insert top stopper about 3 inches above collar

4



Fix bails, adjust bottom stopper so thread is straight and collar rests on it. Thread faces keeper

INCORRECT!!



Threads not straight. Sways with wind and touches keeper's gloves or bat.
Fix: adjust bottom stopper



Collar "sandwiched" between stoppers. Cannot freely move and absorb stress.
Fix: move top stopper upward

PRE-GAME CHECK!

- ✓ 1. All parts in good condition. Else, replace unit.
- ✓ 2. Both stoppers present.
- ✓ 3. Threads straight.
- ✓ 4. Collar freely moves up/down between stoppers.
- ✓ 5. Thread faces wicketkeeper, not bowler.
